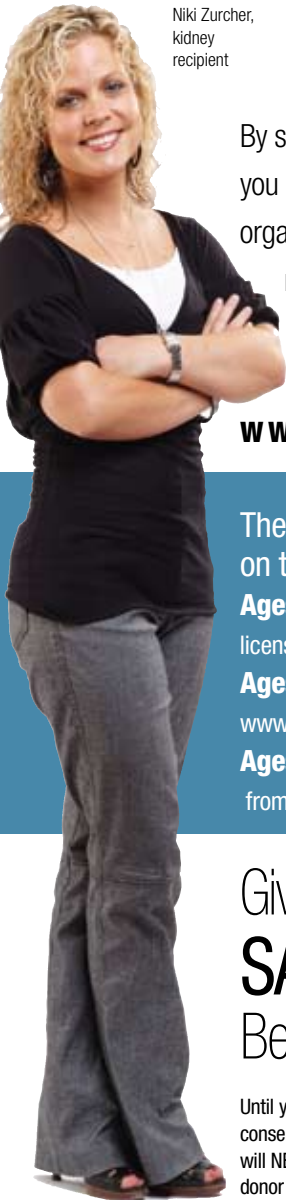

Until you are 18, your family will be asked for consent at the time of donation. Your medical care will NEVER be compromised because of your donor designation. Do not rule yourself out as a donor due to age or health.

Don't Wait to Donate

Every **two seconds** someone in America needs blood.
To be a blood donor in Oregon or Washington, you must:

- Be at least 16 years old; weigh at least 110 pounds
- Be in good general health
- Have written parental/guardian consent
if you are 16 in Oregon; 16 or 17 in Washington
