Workplace Partners for Life, formerly Community Champions, was begun in 1997 by Donate Life Northwest volunteer, Herb Stepper. While waiting for his heart transplant, Herb used his time to educate communities about the critical need for organ, eye and tissue donors. Calling upon his business contacts, Herb arranged for educational brochures to be given to their employees. Herb Stepper received his heart transplant in February 1998.

The Donate Life Northwest Workplace Partners program is part of the U.S. Secretary of Health and Human Services *Workplace Partnership for Life* initiative.

Donate Life Northwest is a 33-year old nonprofit organization whose mission is to save and enhance lives through the promotion of organ, eye and tissue donation in Oregon and Southwest Washington.
