- Transplant Recipient Grant: Support for medication co-payments, delinquent insurance premiums, rent, or any other essential living expenses that contribute to a successful transplant recovery for transplant recipients. Submitted post-transplant.
- Living Donor Grant: Support for living donors who will experience extreme financial need as a result of loss of wages during the time needed to recover after surgery. Submitted at least 2-3 weeks pre-transplant.

- Health Insurance Premium Program: Assistance with health insurance premiums for those on dialysis
- Safety Net Grant Program: Support with health care expenses not covered by insurance such as cost of transportation to dialysis, over-the-counter medicines, co-payments, or medical supplies.
